WELCOME TO HOTEL MESTARI

Hotel Mestari, in the Master Builders' House at the corner of Fredrikinkatu and Eerikinkatu, is a new meeting place in the centre of Helsinki where modern individuality meets an eventful and fascinating history.

Hotel Mestari is the latest chapter in the story of the Master Builders' House, which began in the 1930s. The origins of the building are still reflected in Mestari's philosophy, which respects the manual skills of the builders: in the hotel's rugged, masculine style, many of the original elements of the building are left exposed.

MASTER YOUR STAY

A modern touch gives Mestari its sense of individuality. Each guest can build their ideal stay at Mestari, with a choice of eight room categories and additional experiential services. For example, guests can order the relaxing **Cool Down** service for the room, the **Romance** package for the perfect end to a romantic evening, or the **Groom Your Gear** package to ensure that the party shoes are sparkling and the atmosphere is electric.

Mestari also offers a service called **Choose Your Timing**, which allows guests to choose their arrival and departure times according to their needs and daily rhythms. At Hotel Mestari, you can come and go whenever you please, and there is no need to stress about waking up in time or missing out on breakfast.



The versatile Verstas

Hotel Mestari's meeting rooms serve their purpose and meet the needs of every guest. At Hotel Mestari, you can take a seat at a round table for a cosy discussion or hold hybrid business events for hundreds of people. The lifestyle mindset was shifted up a gear in the design of the meeting and event services – and so **Hotel Mestari's Verstas** was born. In keeping with the setting, guests can book more than just a meeting room – they can enjoy comprehensive service. In addition to the setting and catering, we ensure that our customer's goals are satisfied.

The Verstas does not compromise on technology, service, style and endless possibilities for self-expression. Alongside the highly adaptable spaces, events can be supplemented with the addition of sauna evenings or cocktail courses, among other things. The diverse facilities at the hotel make it possible to hold distinctively individual workshops, business forums or even bachelor parties. The icing on the cake of the meeting experience is a 30-square-metre media wall two storeys high, which is visually stunning and immediately enhances the atmosphere of game, movie or gala evenings.

The **restaurant** is divided into different areas ranging from the atrium balcony to the long benches on the floor. The restaurant contains spacious rooms for larger groups, as well as various nooks and booths for couples and people dining alone. The restaurant can seat up to 220 people.

The **atrium balcony** is an atmospheric intermediate level in the heart of the hotel. It can be separated from the public parts of the restaurant, making it the ideal venue for events such as birthday dinners for large groups. The maximum capacity is 52 people.

Creative areas allow guests to spend relaxing time together, with or without a programme of events. For example, you can play table football with friends or arrange a Play-Doh workshop as a meeting breakout activity. The rooms range in size from 55 m² to 116 m². Depending on the room, the capacity is between 18 and 52 people.

The **function rooms** are a great solution for cosier meetings, offering a suitably peaceful space for making important decisions and helping to create ideas. The rooms range in size from $27\,\mathrm{m}^2$ to $39\,\mathrm{m}^2$. Depending on the room, the capacity is between 12 and 16 people.

The **banqueting hall** is a highly flexible space that can accommodate large celebrations just as well as seminars. The enormous media wall is visually stunning and offers endless opportunities for creating just the right atmosphere. The hall has a floor area of 150 m². The capacity is between 48 and 140 people.

The meeting spaces are a collection of more traditional meeting and workshop rooms for intensive working and creative ideation. Some of the meeting rooms can be combined to make them even more spacious.

The rooms range in size from 50 m² to 110 m².

The capacity is between 16 and 100 people.

Rooms

In Hotel Mestari's exquisite rooms, guests can enjoy a cafetière of the master roaster's coffee while curled up on an airy Joutsen down duvet. Each room has optional extra services for added experiences. Hotel Mestari's rooms can host movie evenings with friends and moments of indulgence far away from the day-to-day.

As befits the historic building, every room is unique and a different size. Hotel Mestari has a total of **eight room categories**.

The MASTER BUILDER PENTHOUSE is an absolutely stunning top-floor apartment bathed in light, allowing guests to enjoy panoramic views over the vibrant city from two different balconies. The apartment has two rooms, one of which can be either a living room or a second bedroom.

The MASTER BUILDER SUITE is a luxuriously cosy corner apartment at the corner of Eerikinkatu and Fredrikinkatu with enough space to host a group of friends for an evening together. The apartment has two rooms, one of which can be either a living room or a second bedroom.

ARCHITECT BALCONY KING is a room that exudes glamour where guests can enjoy panoramic views of the vibrant city from their own balcony, wrapped in a Mestari bathrobe.

ENGINEER LOFT KING is a two-storey room full of surprises for unforgettable movie nights. The internal balcony is an ideal place to spend an evening with friends, watching a film projected onto the opposite wall. This inventively decorated room bears all the hallmarks of engineering excellence.

BRICKLAYER EXECUTIVE KING is a spacious and artfully executed room for a luxurious stay. The divan in the seating corner is a great place to immerse yourself in a book, and the plush armchairs are perfect for enjoying a glass of wine.

Restaurant

Restaurant LATIN BISTRO & BAR MAESTRO 51 is the fiery heart of Hotel Mestari, where uncompromising Nordic tradition meets southern passion and bold flavours. The restaurant's menu was inspired by the South American food culture, as well as a combination of experimentation and pleasure – using sustainable, high-quality ingredients sourced from Finland and abroad. The heart of the Latin-inspired kitchen is the grill, which imbues a depth of flavour and colour on the plate.

A relaxed, South American approach is reflected in the restaurant's philosophy: breakfasts are served all day, and local residents can enjoy a Maestro brunch at weekends. During the day, Maestro keeps step with the rhythm of the city, and the restaurant promises lunch within 5–15 minutes. As the day turns to evening, the restaurant becomes a meeting place where guests can choose an area with the best atmosphere for them.

The Maestro 51 bar welcomes guests and friends until the early hours of the morning. An extensive selection of artisan tequilas and rums and a cocktail menu designed by master bartender Mauricio Allende keeps guests coming back again and again.
